

# Temporary Closure of Church Footpath

You will have noticed that the paving slabs at the bottom end of the path are cracking and will in time become a health and safety hazard. At the top end the tarmac is rough and not wide enough for mobility scooters. Even buggies find it difficult. Something needs to be done!

We are so grateful to Messes. Mick George Ltd. for making a grant of £15,000 towards the improvement of the full length of the footpath between High Street and Back Lane. The unsightly area of rough concrete outside the building will also be replaced.

***Weather permitting, we anticipate the work will be carried out during February, at which time the footpath will be closed apart from access to the church building.***

We have also received small grants from Northamptonshire Historic Churches Trust and All Churches Trust to help with the cost of replacing the main doors and schoolroom door. This ought to be done by the end of January.

We are sorry for any inconvenience all this work may cause but the result will be a safe footpath accessible to all and a much better appearance all round.
