Link to Hope are a Christian organisation based in Worthing who deliver shoeboxes to families or elderly people in Eastern Europe, living in poverty and extremely challenging conditions and shoeboxes are distributed regardless of race or religious beliefs.

The leaflet explains everything you need to know about what items to pack in a shoebox, either for a family or an elderly person, how to wrap the shoebox and attach the £2.00 delivery charge.

Packed and wrapped shoeboxes need to be at the Shared Church no later than Sunday 21st October when they will be dedicated during the morning service before being taken to the collection point in Northampton.

Please get in touch with me if you would like to take part in the appeal but are not sure what it is all about and I do have a supply of empty shoeboxes should you require one. I also have a supply of knitted hats and gloves for sale for £1 each which can be included in a shoebox.
