Despite current restrictions due to Covid-19, our plans to take part in this years Shoebox Appeal are still going ahead, albeit in slightly different circumstances. Many people have said that they would like to pack a box but are short of items and others have said that they do not feel able to take part this year. Do not worry! As is the way of life nowadays, we are able to help and have come up with Plan B. Here are the options available to you.

1. You pack your own shoebox. We have a large stock of surplus items and if you tell us what you need, we will do our best to supply the items, pack them in a sealed bag and deliver them to you. Hats and gloves/mitts are available to buy for £1.00 each and this will help to recoup money to purchase wool for next year.
2. We pack a box for you for a **minimum donation of £3.00**. This donation cannot be paid online to Link to Hope. We will collect the donation and send it direct to the charity as we need to send the correct amount of money for the total of boxes.
3. You go online to Link to Hope www.linktohope.co.uk and they will pack a box for you for the sum of £20.00

So, that's the three options available to everyone and we do hope that you will use one of them. We have lots of spare items, empty shoeboxes and Link to Hope leaflets, all we are waiting for is for you to contact us and tell us what it is you need.

Shoebboxes and knitted blankets need to be with us no later than 18th October and we are planning a collection run.

Yes, it's all very different from previous years but we can, as a church, do all we are able to bring some comfort to those in Eastern Europe who could really do with our help.
